

Student Dashboard

Overview for Families

As part of our Ready Classroom Math this year, students have access to online resources to support their learning! Students can log in to their Ready Classroom student dashboard at home and at school.



What is the Student Dashboard?

The student dashboard is a personalized digital experience for students. At school students use the dashboard to access lessons or assessments assigned by their teacher and to play adaptive learning games.

How can we use the Student Dashboard at home?

At home, students can access the same dashboard they have at school. They can play their learning games or work on a practice activity assigned by their teacher (when available). Some features, found along the bottom of the dashboard, you will want to check out with your child are:

Learning Games: These highly motivating games adapt to your child's level as they play and support them in developing fluency and number sense.

Bookshelf: See a virtual copy of your child's math book, including videos about the math concepts in each unit and the family letters for each lesson that explain the math learning goals and give you an activity to do with your child at home.

Tools: Access virtual math tools for solving problems such as base ten blocks, counters and ten frames, or fraction pieces.

Another feature, located in the upper right-hand corner of the dashboard, the ***Family Center*** link will take you to the i-Ready Family Center website and give you more information about supporting your child's growth.

How can we access the Student Dashboard from home?

Students access their dashboard through the Clever single sign on platform.

To access it at home follow these steps:

1. Go to www.clever.com
2. Click log in as a student (in the upper right-hand corner)
3. Follow the prompt and type in the school name.
4. Log in using your child's google account from school.

Their email is their first name and last name @thomastonschools.org

Their password is their 8-digit birth date MMDDYYYY

For example:

Susie (given name Susan) Snowflake born January 7, 2012

Email: susansnowflake@thomastonschools.org

Password: 01072012

5. Click on the i-Ready App icon:




6. If told to choose a subject, select Math.

How can we access the Student Dashboard on an i-pad?

1. Download the "i-Ready for Students" application from the App Store.
2. Download the "Clever - Instant Login" application from the App Store.



3. Open the Clever App and follow the steps 3-6 from above to log in through Clever. After clicking on the i-Ready App icon in Clever (step 5) you may see the message, "Open this page in 'i-Ready'?" Click "Open." The i-Ready for Students application will open and your child should be able to use the dashboard.
